Recently signatures were collected on a petition asking the Michigan Employment Relations Commission (MERC) to hold an election to decertify DFSE Local 4750 as the bargaining representative for employees of the Dearborn Schools. The deadline to submit the petition to MERC was March 31st.

As of April 8, 2016 NO PETITION HAS BEEN FILED.

Members still on probation or not enrolled, or owing back dues, are not eligible to nominate candidates, vote, or hold office.

DFSE DIRECT DUES COLLECTION

Thank you to everyone who has completed your enrollment. We are very close to meeting our first round goal of 50% of members enrolled for direct dues payment!

We will finish our building visits at the end of April, and on Tuesday and Thursday, May 3 and 5, Christy McGillivray and the direct dues team will be in the lobby at Ten Eyck from 11am to 6pm for members to complete their enrollment. If you have not yet enrolled, please stop by and complete your enrollment.

Dues Amounts Explained

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The example below shows how the amounts on the enrollment letter are determined. Installment payments are your total dues divided by twenty, whether you are a ten, eleven or twelve month employee.

In the example below, \$10.00 is used as the hourly wage only to show how the amounts are calculat-

ed. Please use **your hourly rate and number of pay periods** to determine **your** yearly dues.

Choice 1: YEARLY DUES PAID IN FULL (EXAMPLE)

Ten month employee	\$10.00 times 22 pay periods	=	\$220.00 yearly dues
Eleven month employee	\$10.00 times 24 pay periods	=	\$240.00 yearly dues
Twelve month employee	\$10.00 times 26 pay periods	=	\$260.00 yearly dues

Members may pay their dues in full by check or money order, due by August 31, 2016

Choice 2: YEARLY DUES PAID IN INSTALLMENTS (EXAMPLE)

Ten month employee	\$220.00 divided by 20 installments =	\$11.00 bi-weekly payment
Eleven month employee	\$240.00 divided by 20 installments =	\$12.00 bi-weekly payment
Twelve month employee	\$260.00 divided by 20 installments =	\$13.00 bi-weekly payment

Members may pay their dues through ACH payments from their checking or savings account. Payments will be deducted September 16, 2016 through June 09, 2017

BillHighway will collect a fee of 2% of the payment amount for each ACH payment.

Ten month employee	\$11.00 times .02 = .22 per payment	$(.22 \times 20 = $4.40 \text{ total cost})$
Eleven month employee	12.00 times .02 = .24 per payment	$(.24 \times 20 = $4.80 \text{ total cost})$
Twelve month employee	\$13.00 times .02 = .26 per payment	$(.26 \times 20 = $5.20 \text{ total cost})$



If you are called to a meeting with management that you suspect will be disciplinary in nature, you have the right to request union representation under the U.S. Supreme Court ruling on Weingarten Rights.
