Bus Driver <u>Pat Proulx</u> was commended by the superintendent for her efforts in representing our District at a recent job fair. "Patricia did an excellent job of jumping in at the last minute to spend the day working the fair to recruit drivers to our district."

Media Tech Specialist <u>Gordon Scannell</u> was also commended by the superintendent for his efforts in arranging for Dearborn Public Schools students to talk with an astronaut aboard the International Space Station on October 27.

"Mr. Scannell was responsible for bringing this rare, one-of-a-kind opportunity to Dearborn students through the Amateur Radio on the International Space Station Program (ARISS) which promotes learning opportunities as part of the Science, Technology, Education and Math (STEM) initiative. He volunteered many hours arranging the technical details for the program with NASA and ARISS. He also set up the large antenna on the roof of the Michael Berry Career Center and used much of his own radio equipment that enabled students to speak with the astronaut on the space station as it passed within communications range."

Secretary IV at McDonald School <u>Noor Fahmy</u> received a grant through UM Dearborn's Elliott Initiative Business Idea Pitch to support her "Design Change" project Boxes for Humanity. "Boxes for Humanity will have public school districts team up with food banks, such as Gleaners Community, and Forgotten Harvest, to provide food for families who are in need of assistance."

Paraprofessionals <u>Sherri Maibaum</u> and <u>Ruth Sorenson</u> were recognized in the Special Education Department "Special Edition" newsletter for their work with special education students. Weingarten Rights

If you are called to a meeting with management that you suspect will be disciplinary in nature you have the right to request union representation under the U.S. Supreme Court ruling, Weingarten Rights.
