Dear Members,



FOCUS ON THE CONSTITUTION



The Constitution of the Dearborn Federation of School Employees Local 4750 is a set of rules that provides an agreement and understanding of how union business is conducted.

Some rules in our Constitution are required by Federal or State law. Other rules, such as our objectives, the responsibilities and duties of the Executive Board, meeting days and times, and the amount of our dues and fees are specific to our union and are agreements made by the members.

Article XXVI of our Constitution states that our Federation will remain affiliated with the American Federation of Teachers and the AFL-CIO. Our affiliation means that we are also bound by the Constitutions of the National and State Organizations.

THIS MONTHS FOCUS: ARTICLE X — MANAGEMENT RIGHTS

Subject to the terms of this Agreement, and except as modified by the specific terms of this Agreement, the Employer retains all rights and powers to manage the Dearborn Public Schools and Henry Ford Community College, and to direct its employees.

The Union recognizes these management rights and responsibilities as conferred by the Laws and Constitution of the State of Michigan and as are inherent in the rights and responsibilities to manage the Public School System, including, but not limited to, the right:

<u>10A.</u> To the exclusive management and administrative control of the school system and its properties and facilities, and the activities of its employees during employee working hours;

10B. To hire all employees and, subject to the provisions of law, to determine their qualifications and the conditions for their continued employment, or their dismissal or demotion; and to promote, and transfer all such employees;

discretion in connection therewith shall be limited only by the specific and express terms of this Agreement and then only to the extent such specific and express terms hereof are in conformance with the Laws and Constitution of the State of Michi-

<u>10C.</u> To determine the hours of work and the duties, responsibilities, and assignments of employees, and the terms and conditions of employment.

The exercise of the foregoing powers, rights, authority, duties, and responsibilities by the Employer, the adoption of policies, rules, regulation, and practices and furtherance thereof, and the use of judgment and discretion in connection therewith shall be limited only by the specific and express terms of this Agreement and then only to the extent such specific and express terms hereof are in conformance with the Laws and Constitution of the State of Michigan, and the Laws and Constitution of the United States.
