MILLAGE! MILLAGE! MILLAGE!

February 27, 2024 is the date for the vote on the millage renewal by the residents of Dearborn. There is nothing more important than the passage of this renewal as it will impact all of us. This millage is not a new tax and is not a bond for infrastructure. It is for the operation of our district which means it is used for the wages and salaries of employees. If this millage passes, homeowners will see their tax cap drop from 6.17 mills to a maximum of 4 mills because the district only collected 2.04 mills this year. Absentee ballots have already been mailed to those who are eligible. The DFSE, is urging its members, who are residents of Dearborn, to approve this renewal, whether you vote absentee or inperson, it is important that you vote. As stated, this renewal is for money that pays our wages and salaries and is critical to the continued operation of the district with the current staffing levels. The union will host a phone bank as we

get near February 27th. If you would like to participate in calling fellow employees to remind them to vote and to support the millage, please contact the union office for more details.
